- Central Flyway
- "Grasslands"
- Grassland
- Short-, Mixed-, and some Tallgrass Prairie
- Savanna
- Shrub-grass
- Desert grass



## Central Grasslands

- Canada (3 Provinces)
- Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba
- United States (10 States)
- Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wyoming, Nebraska, Kansas, Colorado, Oklahoma, New Mexico, Texas
- Mexico (8+ States)
- Chihuahua, Coahuila, Nuevo León, Durango, Zacatecas, San Luis Potosí, Guanajuato, Querétaro
- South to North $=3500 \mathrm{~km}, 2175$ miles; 35 hours driving
- East to west $=885 \mathrm{~km}$, 550 miles
